As defined by the United States Alcohol, Tax and Trade Bureau (TTB) Code of Federal Regulations (27 CFR 5.22), "Bourbon (21% Rye)" is a bourbon whiskey distilled in the United States at not exceeding 160 proof from a fermented mash of grain of which not less than 51% was corn grain (maize) and stored in charred new oak containers.
